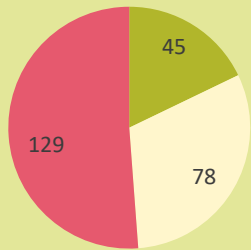


How our practice, work, and home lives changed over the course of the pandemic

 Mann-Whitney test used to test for significance:
 p-value < .05 -> *
 p-value < .01 -> **
 p-value < .001 -> ***
 Men/Women's responses regarding home impact were statistically significantly different, so these have been presented in addition to the overall responses.

Personal risk of acquiring an infectious disease like COVID-19 and/or passing it on to family. N = 252; 3.6 (1.3)

Clinical Practice

48% are **concerned** or **very concerned** about the medical legal risks of making their clinical practice virtual. N = 237; 2.5 (1.2)

66% have **fewer** face to face clinics. N = 227; 2.1 (1.4)

21% have **substantial** difficulty paying admin assistant salary. N = 226; 2.8 (1.1)

25% perceive a **substantial** reduction in patient billings. N = 235; 2.8 (1.2)

Interactions with colleagues. N = 250; 2.3 (1.4)
