






Unconscious Bias: *implicit* attitude, stereotype, motivation, or assumption that can occur without one's knowledge, control or intention.1



Equity: The treatment of people that recognizes and is inclusive of their differences by ensuring that every individual is provided with what they need to thrive, which may differ from the needs of others.

Diversity: Observable and nonobservable characteristics which are constructed – and sometimes chosen - by individuals, groups, and societies to identify themselves (e.g. culture, ethnicity, gender, sexuality).2
